<p>Step 2: Describe the underlying feeling.</p> <p><i>There's not enough room, and kids are getting hurt.</i></p>	<p>Step 2: Describe the underlying feeling.</p> <p><i>Now there will be beds for everyone. When so many people stay together in one house, people may have to sleep on the floor.</i></p>
<p>Step 3: Redirect the behavior.</p> <p><i>Let's make some room on the floor so everyone will have room to sleep.</i></p>	<p>Step 3: Say what you're going to do or offer ways to extend play.</p> <p><i>Let's make everyone comfy. Would you like me to find a blanket and pillow for you?</i></p>
<p>Step 4: Suggest a positive resolution.</p> <p><i>Now we're all comfy.</i></p>
